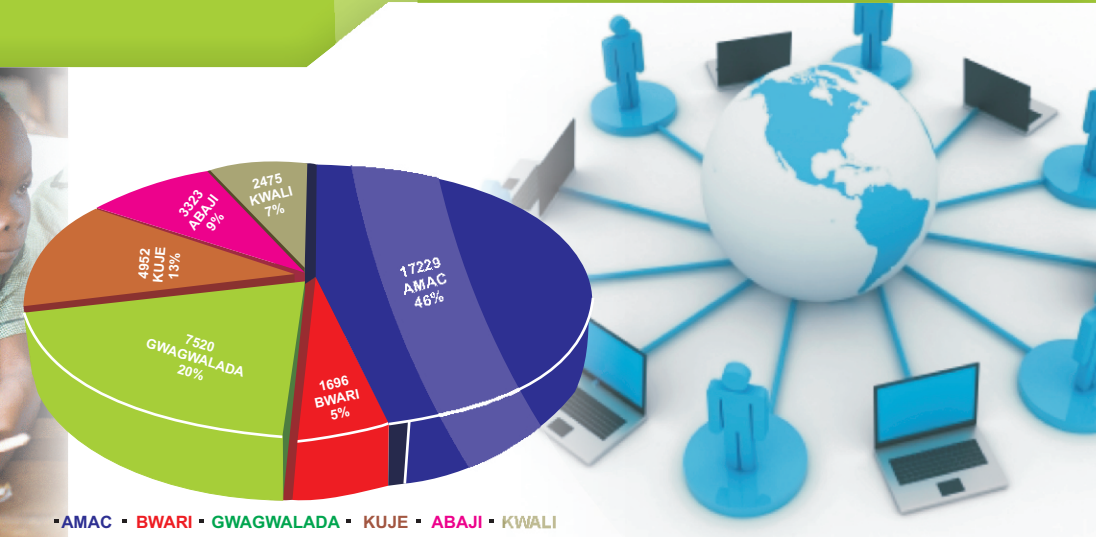

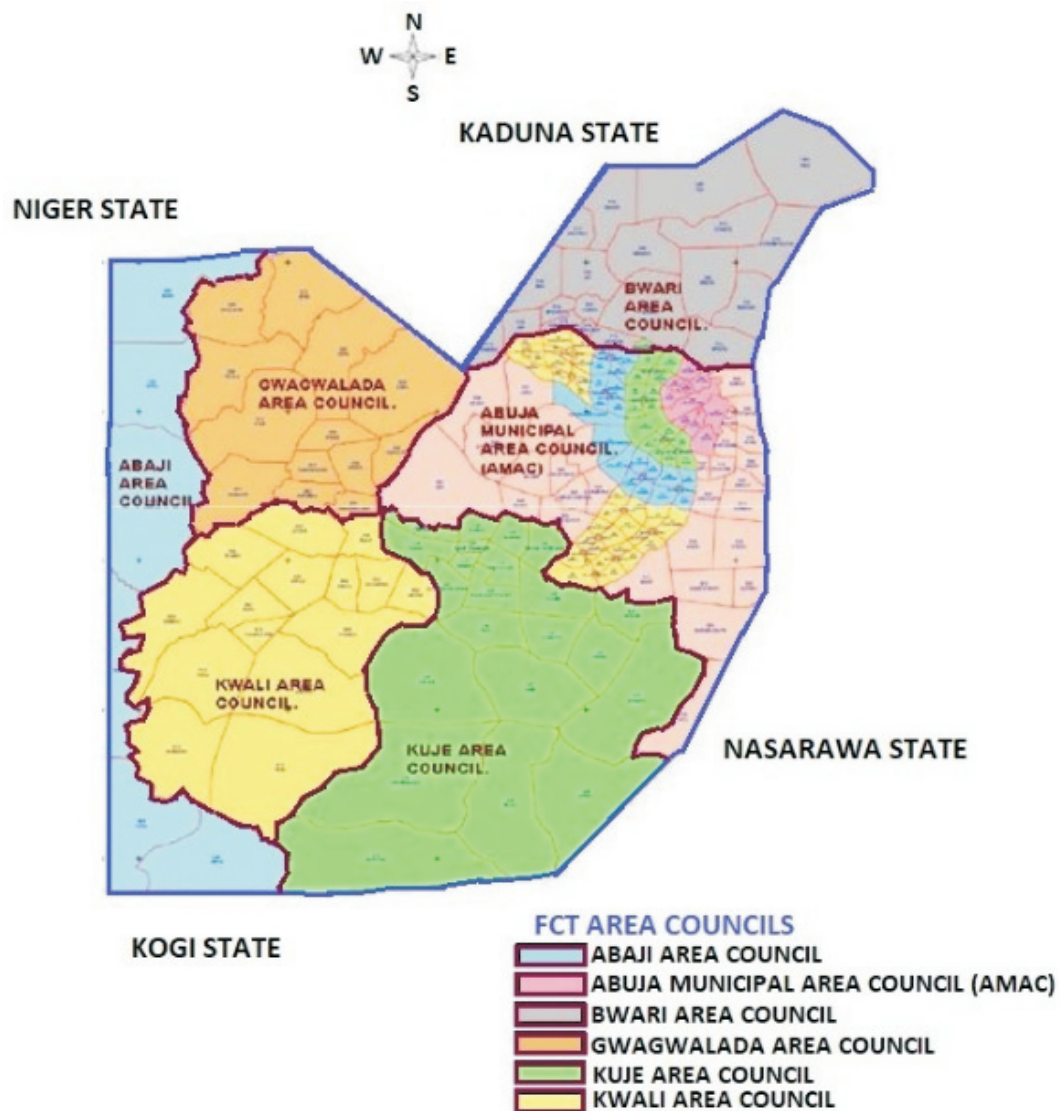

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Education data is a veritable tool for any meaningful planning and delivery of education, globally and in Nigeria. It is for this reason that FCT Education Secretariat took up the challenge to print and disseminate her 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 academic years' data as a follow up to that of 2009/2010 and 2010/2011 academic sessions. In this volume, we report the 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 annual school census data. Evidence from data shows, as in the previous print, that enrolment into FCT schools continues to increase at both the public and private sectors. Again, number of private schools in the Territory continues to outnumber the public schools, but enrolment into public schools remains higher. In other words, there are more children studying in limited number of public school facilities than are required, and by implication over stretching available infrastructural facilities and educational resources such as teachers, text books and others, in those public schools.

This document is arranged in five sections with each section displaying tables on the relevant school data from the Annual School Census data of 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 depending on the sub-title of the section. The data were collected using the Annual School Census instrument, which is a uniform instrument for schools data collection in Nigeria. The last section, which is Section 5 presents tables on basic education indicators of access, quality, equity and efficiency in the FCT education sector. These indicators are globally understood measures for assessing the state or health of education in every setting. The tables in the 4 sections of this book show the following data:

1. Schools in the FCT by level of education for public and private schools: ECCDE, primary, nomadic, special needs, JSS, SSS, public science & technical senior secondary schools
2. Enrolment by level of education in public and private schools, by area councils and by age as well as enrolment of children with disabilities in the public and private schools
3. FCT teachers' distribution by level and by area council -public and private
4. Facilities in schools by area council and ownership- classrooms, toilets, access to water, power, health facilities, library, laboratories, computers, play ground and perimeter fencing
5. Education indicators: access, equity, quality, and efficiency
6. The appendixes contain list of schools by area council for both public and private schools.

Finally, major highlights of the basic education indicators for FCT show the two academic sessions of 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 presented side by side as in the tables in sections 1-5. This mode of presenting the two years side by side makes for easy comparative analysis of indicators for those two years. Under indicators of access for instance, there are measures showing increases in the Gross Enrolment Ratios (GER) of children's enrolled into early childhood education (pre-primary), and primary schools, but a slight drop in the access rate into junior secondary schools and senior secondary





schools. Drop in the access rate into junior secondary schools from 85.5% in 2012/2013 to 84.05% in 2013/2014 is a development to be watched closely because basic education should be free and compulsory. In other words, every child of school age in the FCT is expected to move from primary school into junior secondary school in order to complete basic education. However, for senior secondary level, students are encouraged to move beyond basic education into senior secondary schools but it is not compulsory. Besides, it is estimated that about 30% of students graduating from basic education may wish to move on to vocational schools for skills acquisition.

Furthermore, there are indicators of quality such as the one showing percentage of qualified teachers in FCT schools by level of education and also by area council, and according to gender, thus reflecting equity issues as well. In addition, the tables on indicators also show student's level of access to basic school infrastructure such as classrooms, school furniture and power supply. Access of schools to water and toilet, which indicate level of sanitation in the schools for both public and private sectors, is an issue of access as well of quality and equity depending on the perspective one decides to interpret the measures (Tables 89-96). On the whole, the document is a reflection of the state of education in the FCT to the extent that the Nigerian Annual School Census instrument could accommodate. However, FCT has gone a little further to include data on non-formal education and higher education, which are not part of the ASC data collection instrument, so as to present a balanced view of its educational set up. Finally, the appendix section contains list of public schools in the FCT according to levels of education and the area councils, as well as list of accredited private schools and non-formal education vocational centres. The Federal Capital Territory is a fast growing capital and experiences the challenges of all capital cities of emerging large and highly populated developing nations, and so, the indices for its education system, though not yet very good, shows continued improvement, and this should foster hope for a better state of education in Nigeria as a nation.

## Definitions:

<b>Access indicators:</b>	They are indicators used to measure <b>the percentage of Habitations having access to schooling facilities.</b>
<b>Compulsory Education:</b>	The number of years or age span during which children are legally obliged to attend school.
<b>Dropout Rate by Grade:</b>	Proportion of pupils from a cohort enrolled in a given grade at a given school year who are no longer enrolled in the following school year.
<b>Education indicators:</b>	They are measures of the outcomes of educational institutions, programs, and practices, where resulting statistics are intended to inform educational policy.
<b>Gender Parity Index:</b>	Ratio of female to male values of a given indicator.
<b>Gross Enrolment Ratio:</b>	Number of pupils or students enrolled in a given level of education, regardless of age, expressed as a percentage of the official school-age population corresponding to the same level of education. For the tertiary level, the population used is the 5-year age group starting from the official secondary school graduation age.
<b>Indicator:</b>	This is a quantitative or qualitative variable that provides a simple and reliable basis for assessing achievement, change or performance.
<b>Net Enrolment Rate:</b>	Total number of pupils or students in the theoretical age group for a given level of education enrolled in that level, expressed as a percentage of the total population in that age group.
<b>Out-of-School Children-Primary:</b>	Children in the official primary school age range who are not enrolled in either primary or secondary schools.
<b>Percentage of Female Teachers:</b>	The number of female teachers at a given level of education expressed as a percentage of the total number of teachers (male and female) at the same level in a given school year.
<b>Percentage of Repeaters:</b>	Total number of pupils who are enrolled in the same grade as the previous year, expressed as a percentage of total enrolment in



the given grade of **education**.

**Percentage of Trained Teachers:** Number of teachers who have received the minimum organized teacher training required for teaching at the specified level of education in the given country, expressed as a percentage of the total number of teachers at the same level of education.

**Promotion Rate by Grade:** Proportion of pupils from a cohort enrolled in a given grade at a given school year who study in the next grade in the following school year.

**Pupil-Teacher Ratio:** The average number of pupils per teacher at a given level of education, based on headcounts of both pupils and teachers.

**Quality indicators:** They are statistical measures that give an indication of output quality. However, some quality indicators can also give an indication of process quality.

**Repetition Rate by Grade:** Proportion of pupils from a cohort enrolled in a given grade at a given school year who study in the same grade in the following school year.

**School-age Population:** Population of the age group theoretically corresponding to a given level of education as indicated by theoretical entrance age and duration.

**School life expectancy:** The number of years a person of school entrance age can expect to spend within the specified level of education.

**Transition Rate:** The number of pupils (or students) admitted to the first grade of a higher level of education in a given year, expressed as a percentage of the number of pupils (or students) enrolled in the final grade of the lower level of education in the previous year.
