

1. Communicable diseases generally involves the lower socioeconomic group while Non Communicable diseases involves generally affluent class
2. Vehicles of transmission and the vectors play major role in the spread of diseases **while** Dietary habits, environment and lifestyle play a role in the causation of these diseases
3. Examples are common cold, pneumonia, tuberculosis **while** examples are diabetes, Arthritis, high blood pressure, stroke, scurvy
